gender development and globalization is the leading primer on global feminist economics and development gender is a development issue because social considerations are not easily incorporated into institutions such as policies regulations markets and organizations this process is often referred to as the mainstreaming of gender in development institutions women are often in a disadvantaged position in terms of access to assets services information and formal decision making status gender equality is considered a critical element in achieving decent work for all women and men in order to effect social and institutional change that leads to sustainable development with equity and growth gender equality refers to equal rights responsibilities and opportunities that all persons should enjoy regardless of whether one is born male or female gender developmental scientists are concerned with age related changes in gender typing and more broadly with many issues about the emergence and patterning of gendered behaviors and thinking description of these changes is vitally important as it informs theoretical approaches to gender development using a broad lens on age related changes provides important information describing how development occurs but shorter time frames are also useful for identifying processes that may underlie developmental patterns gender has been increasingly acknowledged as a critical variable in analysis and development planning gender is an expression of power in social relationship between men and women the book will be very useful to academicians researchers planners students ngos civil societies and all those who are interested in women studies in general and gender issues in contexts in particular

women s rights are the rights and entitlements claimed for women and girls worldwide and formed the basis for the women s rights movement in the nineteenth century and feminist movement during the 20th century in some countries these rights are institutionalized or supported by law local custom and behavior whereas in others they are ignored and suppressed they differ from broader notions of human rights through claims of an inherent historical and traditional bias against the exercise of rights by women and girls in favor of men and boys women s rights and social change focuses attention on the way in which women from a number of traditions have been able to bring about change and the manner in which rights have either facilitated or inhibited women s participation in the process of change in the face of injustice people band together to work for change and through their influence what was once unthinkable becomes common this book traces the history of the women s rights movement including the key players watershed moments and legislative battles that have driven social change this book should be of interest to all those interested in gender development and women

in the 1930s the italian fascist regime profoundly changed the landscape of rome s historic centre demolishing buildings and displacing thousands of romans in order to display the ruins of the pre christian roman empire this transformation is commonly interpreted as a failed attempt to harmonize urban planning with fascism s ideological exaltation of the roman empire roads and ruins argues that the chaotic fascist cityscape filled with traffic and crumbling ruins was in fact a reflection of the landscape of the first world war in the radical interwar transformation of roman space paul baxa finds the embodiment of the fascist exaltation of speed and destruction with both roads and ruins defining the cultural impulses at the heart of the movement drawing on a wide variety of sources including war diaries memoirs paintings films and government archives roads and ruins is a richly textured study that offers an

original perspective on a well known story

the book asks important questions about the seemingly taken for granted quality of feminist perspectives on gender and work about the ways in which both the codes of law and those of genre frame the female lawyer and about the persistence of anxious constructions of successful women cineaste this book shows how the professional woman of popular film has so often been given a half measure of authority and agency in narratives which though they may register patriarchal crisis are also deeply dedicated to patriarchal restoration lucia convincingly illustrates how the female lawyer s status as a figure with access to the public sphere and to the law most often necessitates that she herself will be interrogated and put on trial diane negra university of east anglia author of off white hollywood american culture and ethnic female stardom as real women increasingly entered the professions from the 1970s onward their cinematic counterparts followed suit women lawyers in particular were the protagonists of many hollywood films of the reagan bush era serving as a kind of shorthand reference any time a script needed a powerful career woman yet a close viewing of these films reveals contradictions and anxieties that belie the films apparent acceptance of women s professional roles in film after film the woman lawyer herself effectively ends up on trial for violating norms of femininity and patriarchal authority in this book cynthia lucia offers a sustained analysis of women lawyer films as a genre and as a site where other genres including film noir maternal melodrama thrillers action romance and romantic comedy intersect she traces hollywood representations of female lawyers through close readings of films from the 1949 adam s rib through films of the 1980s and 1990s including jagged edge the accused and the client among others she also examines several key male lawyer films and two independent films lizzie borden s love crimes and susan streitfeld s female perversions lucia convincingly demonstrates that making movies about women lawyers and the law provides unusually fertile ground for exploring patriarchy in crisis this she argues is the cultural stimulus that prompts filmmakers to create stories about powerful women that simultaneously question and undermine women s right to wield authority

visualizing theory is a lavishly illustrated collection of provocative essays occasional pieces and dialogues that first appeared in visual anthropology review between 1990 and 1994 it contains contributions from anthropologists from cultural literary and film critics and from image makers themselves reclaiming visual anthropology as a space for the critical representation of visual culture from the naive realist and exoticist inclinations that have beleaguered practitioners efforts to date visualizing theory is a major intervention into this growing field
